# Doctors let fingerprints do the talking

Work of art was created by 20,000 professionals as a gesture of solidarity

An artistic expression of solidarity among doctors across the country in the face of increasing incidents of violence against their colleagues made it into the Guinness Book of World Records as the world's largest finger-painting.

The project, started by Naveen Koval, Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at the Kannur Medical College and also an artist, was conceived in October 2015. He, with students of the college, created an outline of the painting on a 29-metre long and 16-metre high canvas. Called 'Ray of Hope,' it shows doctors, their hands bound with stethoscopes.

They divided the canvas into hundreds of pieces and sent them to around 100 medical colleges (with help

with the prescribed colours.
Around 20,000 doctors and
medical students in different
parts of the country
contributed over 15 lakh

finger impressions and sent the pieces back to Dr. Koval. A tailor then helped stitch the canvas back together to make the finished painting. This took until January 2016. The work was first displayed in Kannur Medical College on February 1, 2016. In January this year, Dr. Koval was notified that the painting had made it into the Guinness Book of World Records.

"It is not just a painting but a symbolic representation of our fight to end violence against doctors," said Dr. Koval at a press conference here on Tuesday. He said that the painting's entry into the record book would amplify its message at a time when incidents of attacks on doctors are on the increase.

An IMA official said that the painting wanted to highlight the ray of hope about a future where doctors, the public, media and the government would be much more sensitive to the issue. It was for the first time, they said, that so many doctors had come together for a single cause.
